What You Need to Know about Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in different ways:

- 1. We have standard overdraft practices (Overdraft Privilege Pay) that come with your account.
- 2. We offer overdraft protection plans, such as a link to your other deposit accounts, or a line of credit, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practice. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

What are the <u>standard overdraft practices</u> that come with my account?

We do authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do not authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if Credit Union of Texas pays my overdrafts?

Under our standard overdraft practice:

- We will charge you a fee of \$35.00 each time we pay an overdraft.
- There is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account.
- What if I want CUTX to authorize and pay overdrafts on my ATM and everyday debit card transactions?

You may authorize us to pay overdrafts on ATM and everyday debit card transactions in the following ways:
